### Chair Person Report:

**Museum Mile** permit request: The Chair provided a clarification about the committee decision not to support the expansion of the Museum Mile to 110<sup>th</sup> St. The Museum of African Art is **not open** at this time and no information was provided about programs planned for the area from 106 to 110. The committee supports a future expansion that provides program planning information and the inclusion of EH artists.

**Tito Puente Statue:** A copy of the old letter of support was requested of the organizers of the statue.

**Our Lady Queens of Angels:** Celebrating their 125<sup>th</sup> year anniversary requested a letter of congratulations and was invited to present.

### **Presentation:**

A letter of support was requested by Tom Lunke of the Harlem River Task Force the relocation the 25 gates from 125<sup>th</sup> St stores along the RFK ramp on Second Ave. The gate preservation initiative is in response to the mandate of the 125<sup>th</sup> Rezoning that requires that the store gates should now be transparent and the current gates would be lost.
