2. Informational updates

- 23rd Precinct – P.O. Gibbons – Informational, no shooting incidents in the month of October, NYC marathon coming up
- District Attorney's office – Madai Velez - Report of Domestic Violence, available online based on the last two years, will be used for funding and understanding the overall problem of domestic violence in NYC
- Department of Transportation – Lyle Blackwood
 - Play Street on 105th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenue for East Harlem Scholars Academy - The ticketing issue has been resolved and there are no outstanding issues currently that the loose neighborhood coalition of residents of 105th Street presented. Our committee will continue to work with the residents and the school.
 - Redesign of 124th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenue – DOT has made markings corrections to fix the current issues. Our committee was disappointed with DOT

implementing a different design that was presented initially without letting us know of the changes.
